NCPW Parent & Participant Rules

1. Nonnewaug Chiefs Pop Warner Inc. Football and Cheerleading participants will always show respect to people and property. They will be courteous to their coaches, squad members, staff personnel, and opposing teams. Any incidence of un-sportsmanlike or demoralizing behavior or vandalism will result in a 1 game suspension. A 2nd offense will result in expulsion from the team with no refund of fees paid.
2. Only Coaches, Players, and Team Moms are permitted on the playing field during practice and games.
3. All complaints concerning NCPW should be submitted in writing to the Parent Representative within 72 hours of the incident in question.
4. Football Parents are responsible for providing cleats with rubber bottoms and protective cup. These must be worn during practice and games.
5. Additional travel expenses may be incurred should the team your child is a member of progress beyond play offs . Participation is mandatory.
6. Parents must have players at games 1 hrs. before game time.
7. Volunteerism is vital to our success. Parents are required to complete and hand in a volunteer form.
8. REFUND POLICY: Requested by July 15th full refund; by September 1st ½ refund; NO REFUNDS after September 1st.

NCPW Parent & Participant Code of Conduct

Parents, family members, players and cheerleaders hereby pledge to provide support, care and encouragement to participants in Western Connecticut Pop Warner League. To conduct themselves in a manner which reflects positively on the organization and demonstrates good character by adhering to the Code of Conduct as follows:

1. Learn and know the rules of the game. Play and abide by them.
2. Attend team events regularly and on time. Be both mentally and physically prepared at the start of each event. Conform to the regulations of the league and promptly obey all directions of the coaches, officials, assistants and volunteers.
3. Demonstrate good sportsmanship and fair play, both on and off the field. Always set a positive example for others, particularly younger players.
4. Work hard to improve your skills. Listen, ask questions, and watch others to see how you can better your skills.
5. Be a team player. Learn teamwork and appreciate the contribution each participant makes to the team. Be kind to teammates and standup for each other on and off the field. You may not always be friends, but always be teammates.
6. Play and watch the game or competitions do not officiate it. Refrain from addressing the officials or commenting on their decisions during the game or competition.
7. Players, cheerleaders and parents must maintain control of their emotions. Avoid the use of abusive language, profanity, humiliating remarks, and/ or gestures of ill temper. Never participate in or provoke any physical assault upon anyone.
8. Remember that a teams reputation is built not only on it's ability on the field but also on the sportsmanship, courtesy and manners of each individual participant and parent. Respect the coaches and players of the opposing team and demonstrate appropriate gestures of sportsmanship. Be humble and courteous in defeat.
9. Be upstanding students, avoid detentions and getting into trouble. Schoolwork is more important than any practice or game.
10. Respect all coaches, participants, parents, opponents, and officials both on and off the field.
