PAPERWORK CHECKLIST

Paperwork Included in Packet:

- **Participant Contract & Parental Consent Form:** White Form (2 pages)
*Fill out first page
Parent and Participant sign page 2*
- **Medical Contract:** Green Form (2 pages)
*Page 1: Filled out by parent
Page 2: This document must be signed and dated by the physician in 2007.
The doctor may reference a physical exam on the comment line; however
the date of the physical must not be prior to Jan. 1st 2006.*
- **Player Code of Conduct :** Peach Form
*This must be signed by both the parent and participant. Please take the
time to review these rules with your child.*
- **Medical/Emergency Contact Form:** Turquoise Form
This form will remain with your coach at all times in case of injury/illness
- **Volunteer Form:** Lavender Form (2 pages)
*The success of our program is dependent on everyone pitching in. This
form must be signed and turned in.*
- **Birth Certificate:** A certified copy of the players birth certificate is
required for all first year participants. (Copy with a raised seal) Ideally you will
give us one that we can keep with the paperwork. (Extras are available in the town
clerks office where your child was born.) If you are unable to obtain an extra, then
include a note with the original that you need it returned, along with a photo copy.
- **Report Card:** Each participant must turn in a copy of his or her final report card
showing the entire past year. If your child is in danger of having an average
below 70, please contact us to discuss other options.
- **Additional Information:**
*Football Players: Socks \$5.00 and Girdles \$15.00 will be available to
purchase at helmet day. Players are also required to wear an athletic
supporter and rubber football cleats.
Cheerleaders: The additional monetary outlay for cheerleading uniforms
(sneakers, bloomers, ect.) will be between \$125-\$175 depending on squad.
